## PET EMERGENCY KIT CHECKLIST

$\checkmark \quad$ Flashlight with spare batteries (store in plastic bag with batteries removed)
$\checkmark$ One-week supply of medications
$\checkmark$ Pet first aid kit
$\checkmark$ One-week supply of canned food for each pet
$\checkmark$ One-week supply of dry food for each pet
$\checkmark$ One-week supply of bottled water for each pet
$\checkmark$ Bowls for water and food
$\checkmark$ Spoons for serving canned food
$\checkmark$ Canned food covers
$\checkmark \quad$ Can opener (just in case)
$\checkmark$ Cats: litter box (at least 1 per 2 cats for emergency purposes)
$\checkmark$ Cats: cat litter
$\checkmark$ Cats: litter scoop
$\checkmark \quad$ Cats and dogs: one collar with ID for each pet
$\checkmark$ Cats: one harness and leash for each cat
$\checkmark$ Dogs: one leash (harness if applicable) for each dog
$\checkmark$ Bedding for each animal (keep it small and thin - fleece fabric is a good choice)
$\checkmark$ Lots of paper towels
$\checkmark$ Lots of plastic bags
$\checkmark$ Disinfecting wipes
$\checkmark$ Photo of each pet (write name, special traits, meds, and microchip info. on the back, including chip contact number)
$\checkmark$ Rabies certificate (copy) for each pet
$\checkmark$ Cats and small dogs: safe, sturdy carrier for each pet with padding inside

Nice to have:
$\checkmark$ Toys
$\checkmark$ Treats
$\checkmark$ Cats: catnip
$\checkmark$ Handwarmers or beds that reflect animal's body heat back
