Currently, Stacy serves as President of the Board for PAWSitive Pantry, Treasurer at the Vermont Humane Federation, Treasurer for the MRFERS, and Treasurer/Strategic Director at the United Spay Alliance. She's also a past board member of the Massachusetts Animal Coalition and the New England Federation of Humane Societies, as well as the administrative trustee for the LeBaron Foundation. In addition to organizational roles, Stacy offers consulting services, urging others to address cat overpopulation strategically.

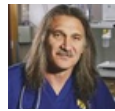

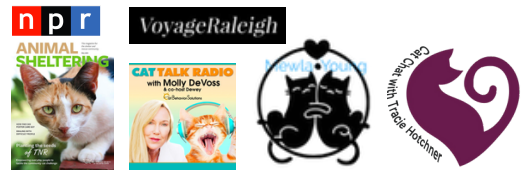

Reach & Impact

- CCP's podcast averages **826** downloads per episode.
- On average, CCP's website receives **7,321** unique site visitors monthly and those visitors average **18,124** page views per month.
- An average CCP Facebook post reaches **36,400** people organically and **2,600** interactions including likes, comments, and shares.
- The CCP Online Conference Community Facebook Group has **2,754** members.
- Monthly email newsletters reach **14,212** subscribers.
- CCP's multi-day virtual conferences, including the Online Cat Conference, Online Kitten Conference and United Spay Alliance Conference receive an average of **252** registrations per event.
- CCP's all-day virtual session, such as Online Feline Leukemia Day and Online Behavior Day receive an average of **362** registrations per event.
- CCP's monthly Trap-Neuter-Return Certification Workshop averages **234** registrations per session.
- CCP's Surrender Prevention Certification Workshops reaches an average of **304** registrations
- The CCP Grant Program has mentored over **255** rescue groups who've received matching grants to fund their programs.
- Approximately **89.8%** of CCP followers are women and **22.35%** are between the ages of 45 and 54.
